Each completed application should contain the following information:

- Fully completed application.
- A letter of support from Department Chair, Division Director or Section Head.
- A one-page cover letter.
- A current biosketch. (*Please use the attached template*).

The cover letter should include:

- A brief description of the applicant's research interests.
- A description of the applicant's career goals, and immediate plans to reach those goals.
- A proposed use for the travel award funds, and a specific description of how the activity/activities will further the applicant's career goals.
